

HOSPITAL ROOF FEATURES IMPRESSIVE DETAILING

This expertly managed installation provided the contractor with challenging detailing, which included many changes in direction, complex internal and external corners, and many plinths of different shapes and sizes that had to be waterproofed and tested before plant and machinery was placed on the roof.

A solar array was also installed on the finished waterproofing system, which required a lot of co-ordination with the mechanical and electrical contractor to ensure that the waterproofing was not damaged.

The commitment and attention to detail of the installation team contributed to the project's success.



COLD APPLIED LIQUID WATERPROOFING

CHALLENGING PROJECT SCHEDULE OF WORKS **ACHIEVED WITH EFFECTIVE PLANNING**

LE CLOS MOURANT is a housing estate in St Clement, Jersey. Large central podiums form the roof of the car parks, as well as a warm roof to some of the accommodation. In addition, the systems were used to waterproof the block work planters with confidence, due to the root resistant property of the membrane.

The Triflex liquid system delivered seamless and self-terminating waterproofing for the warm flat roofs and entrance canopies. The large-scale project meant that the installation team was working around other trades to deliver the schedule of works to time and the project utilised local subcontractors wherever possible to support the Jersey island economy. The attitude and skill of the installation team has ensured a quality finish.

BLACKNEST is a bespoke contemporary residence with a guesthouse and studio in a lakeside setting. The buildings are wrapped in copper which gives the impression of a woodland canopy and the illusion of a boat hull.

The copper coverings were installed onto overhanging soffits, walls, support columns and window surrounds. In addition, the work included copper cappings, stainless steel internal gutter linings and aluminium standing seam roofing on the guesthouse. The project was all fabricated on site.

The support columns for the main house were changed to copper after discussion on site, and the contractor ensured that any rainwater runoff was directed away from the lake to prevent harm to the fish stock.

Situated in Macclesfield, the new First Light Pavilion forms part of the JODRELL BANK DISCOVERY CENTRE.

The uniquely impressive dome was opened to the public in 2022 and blends effortlessly into its natural surroundings.

The shape of the roof provided the operatives with a challenge. A large amount of planning was involved in making sure that the roof was set out correctly. The contracts manager produced a phased plan, splitting the circular

dome into 16 separate segments to ensure correct coverage and sufficient laps on the waterproofing. Although the waterproofing was to be covered by landscaping, the operatives took great pride while installing the Bauder system to keep the Pavilion watertight.

Originally built in 1864 and located in Derby's Cathedral Quarter, the Market Hall is one of the city's most culturally important buildings, which today plays host to a range of independent market traders. To extend the building's lifespan and to counter structural deterioration that has sometimes forced temporary closure, the contractor designed, supplied and installed new standing-seam copper roofing to the central spine of the roof and the four tapered curved corners. All four hipped

corners of the barrel-vaulted structure were slightly different which presented setting out challenges on site. The contractor carried out all work without disturbing internal works or market stalls. The judges were also impressed that the contractor had three apprentices working on the project.


STOCKPORT SCHOOL

This project has been deemed the Industry Choice winner, receiving over 20 per cent of the votes online from the rest of the UK roofing sector. This roof refurbishment project at STOCKPORT SCHOOL was carried out while students and staff studied and taught in the buildings and were on campus. In total 24 individual roofs with many hips and valleys were refurbished using BMI Redland tiles, totalling some 4,000 square metres.

SOMERTON CASTLE was built in 1281, and was soon after gifted to Edward II, but the history of the site goes back to Roman times.

sponsors a local grassroots junior sector of a rugby club.



The site had fallen into disrepair over the years and had been placed on Historic England's Heritage at Risk Register. The leadwork on the tower was completed in three phases, the first being the gutters, which were no more than 400 mm wide and deep sided, with the lowest point being around 1.3 m below the main roof, and with an abutment on the outer edge with some of the code 8 rolls weighing

130 kg each. The gutter included two sandcast sumps. The second phase saw the addition of the code 6 lead to the internal ring wall which carried the main roof. Following this, the main roof covering was installed, consisting of 70 tapered bays using code 6 lead and two oversized bays of code 7 because of the irregular shape of the tower roof.

NOTHING TOO MUCH FOR ICONIC LONDON BUILDING

Logistically and technically, the BATTERSEA POWER STATION development proved a true test of the contractor's workmanship and project management capabilities.

To provide the chimney structures with long-term waterproof protection and stay true to the aesthetic of the repurposed site, the contractor worked with IKO products and



applied mastic asphalt to the bases of the four chimneys, totalling 750 m², as part of a challenging but very rewarding application for the tradespeople working on this iconic building. As a measure of how the contractor went beyond its remit to exceed project

requirements, it designed a mastic asphalt solution to waterproof and line a peregrine falcon's nest within the chimneys. The birds have been resident there for many years, and the 1 m x 1 m square nest will provide them with a permanent home.

St Sidwell's Point Leisure Centre was the first Passivhaus leisure facility in the UK. Consisting of aluminium standing-seam roofing and three different types of rainscreen cladding fixed back to three different backing substrates, this project had two key areas of complexity.

The first and most visually obvious was the base geometry of the project, with almost all elevations and roofs being sloped, tapered, curved or spiralled which *required an enhanced level of accuracy*. The second element was the hidden complexity of the Passivhaus requirement.

At an initial glance, this five-storey building may appear simple, yet this project was anything but, involving the use of numerous different sized and coloured fibre cement and aluminium rainscreen systems, and bringing the façade together seamlessly whilst sitting on numerous planes and projections.



The Ash & Lacy aluminium panels for the rainscreen system each needed to be drawn and dimensioned individually to be installed in a specific location on the building. The installation crew were fed drawings and information digitally, and any queries that arose were addressed with the design team in real time via
Teams, with solutions to any installation
problems agreed to ensure that both time
schedules and quality of workmanship were
preserved, all within a constricted site that
lay within a live operating train station.

Cornwall's **LAUNCESTON COLLEGE** was going through a major development to meet the increasing demand for places in the local area, as well as to improve its infrastructure and facilities for current students.

This included the construction of a new three-storey purpose-built Science and Technology block involving a main flat roof area, two secondary flat roofs and a canopy roof. The contractor faced several challenges throughout the project, including calculating wind loads, designing a tapered insulation scheme that didn't restrict the access doors, working on a live site and managing deliveries.

The attention to detail on the completed BMI Icopal roof areas stood out.



YELLOWSANDS, a nineteenth century arts and crafts building, is full of extraordinary detail. Stuart Wheeler Roofing Ltd was tasked with renovating this incredibly unique and intricate roof.

The contractor used a breathable membrane with reclaimed random Delabole slates to cover the main roof elevations. *The judges were particularly impressed with the swept valley detailing on this project.*





WINNING PROJECT JANE AUSTEN'S HOUSE

The author's home was originally a timber farmhouse built around 500 years ago, and was later used as a coaching inn. Austen lived in the house for the eight years that preceded her death in 1817.

In 1845 the house was returned to the Chawton Estate and divided into three dwellings for estate workers. It was also used as an estate office and a working men's club, before becoming a museum in 1949, and it is now Grade I listed. Working closely with the architect and local conservation officers, the contractor opened up the entire structure to carry out structural timber repairs, reforming the central valleys and rebuilding brick corbels to retain drive spike gutter brackets.

The head tiler allowed their apprentices to lay the Keymer tiles and bonnets whilst under supervision to gain experience.

SIZEABLE NEW WAREHOUSE SCHEME PLUS ENVIRONMENTALLY -CONSIDERATE EXTENSION

THATCHER'S CIDER **WAREHOUSE 2**

Manufacturer: Various products used This project was the second phase of works to facilitate a new high-bay robotic storage system. This phase comprised 124 metre long aluminium standing-seam sheets on the roof and composite panels installed horizontally on the walls.



The roof consisted of two build ups, one of which had ROCKWOOL slab insulation to ensure office space was appropriately soundproofed. The aluminium standing-seam sheets were rolled on the ground and then carried along a specially designed, 34 metrelong scaffold platform from ground floor to the roof level to be installed. Where the original warehouse was extended, the contractor removed, numbered and protected each of the original composite panels and installed them onto the new structure to save them from being sent to landfill. The contractor on this project also undertook the role of principal contractor.

VALLEY DRIVE is part of Gravesham Council's affordable homes project. A crisp, straight, and neat transition was required to give the roof the sheet metal effect proposed in the design. This was achieved by drawing on the installer's knowledge and experience of the Protan membrane system.



single- ply system which would ventilate the ridges, eaves, and valleys of the pitched roof areas. A template was fabricated by the contractor to ensure uniformity.

This produced a seamless, even, and straight finish to the ridges, eaves, and valleys, demonstrative of excellent workmanship by the contractor's installation team.

SMALL-SCALE PROJECT < £25K

DEDICATED CRAFTSMANSHIP RESULTS IN SUCCESSFUL RESTORATION

NAME OF PROJECT THE RIVERSIDE PAVILION

This project comprised the restoration of the tapering large lead finial on the RIVERSIDE PAVILION, located in a private country garden. The finial needed to be dismantled and returned to the workshop so that the timber former could be replicated. With the new European oak structure fitted together in the workshop, the old leadwork was trial fitted before being dismantled and transported to the site for its final fitting.

The original iron centre rod was still in good condition despite being 150 years old. Divided into manageable components the oak structure was carefully hoisted into position and secured whilst maintaining temporary cover. The salvageable embellishments were sandblasted, and the missing embellishments were recast in the workshop. The octagonal timber moulding was re-lined by welding together segments of lead which were fitted in two halves.
