Evidence given to Business and Trade Committee

On 1 July, NFRC Southwest Chair Paul Brain gave oral evidence to the Business and Trade committee to help inform their development of the Small Business Strategy. Paul spoke alongside Federation of Master Builders CEO Brian Berry, discussing issues such as late payment, retentions, and the unequal playing field within construction.

Contribution to position paper published on RC62 Fire Safety Guidance for Solar PV Flat Roof Installations

The NFRC, alongside key industry partners, has published a position paper on the RC62 fire safety guidance for rooftop solar PV installations, advocating for a more risk-based and system-focused approach, particularly for flat roofs. Authored by Bauder's Head of Sustainability Tom Raftery, the paper reflects broad sector consensus and follows productive engagement with RISCAuthority, which has agreed to revise its guidance in future updates.

Latest State of the Industry Report published

The NFRC's Spring 2025 State of the Roofing Industry Report, produced with Barbour ABI, shows a slowdown in workloads and new enquiries, with only 36% of contractors reporting increased activity, down from 48% at the end of 2024. Despite ongoing challenges such as rising costs, recruitment difficulties, and

late payments, there is general optimism, especially in commercial new build and in regions such as the Midlands and Scotland. While confidence among NFRC Members remains strong, the report highlights concerns about political uncertainty and a lack of government support ahead of expected tax changes in Autumn's budget.

Common Assessment Standard update

Build UK has published Version 5 of the Common Assessment Standard (CAS), making the Building Safety section mandatory for all companies looking to remain certified. Numerous major contractors have confirmed they will require compliance with the new standard by 1 October 2025, reinforcing the need for companies to demonstrate organisational capability under the Act. NFRC is supporting Members with detailed guidance and encourages all who require the CAS to act now to ensure they meet their obligations and remain competitive as CAS demand increases.

Press and Social media presence

NFRC has been sharing Members' success stories, providing technical updates, and advocating for reform in key areas throughout the media landscape throughout 2025. Since the beginning of the year, NFRC has recorded over 230 references in the media, across online, broadcast, and print. Our social media presence is steadily growing with a collective audience of over 19,500 individuals who are interested in what NFRC has to say and what our members are up to!



IS IT TIME TO MOVE INTO GREEN ROOFS?

(PART THREE)

In dry climates install a drip irrigation system, or rely on rainwater for low-maintenance roofs in temperate areas. Keep an eye on it so you can see how the sedum is faring; do a little weeding and take out the grasses.

Water newly planted roofs regularly during the establishment phase but make sure the sedum is not sitting in water.

While they typically don't require much maintenance, green roofs and sedum plants like a fertiliser. However, use the right mix and formula. A good sedum fertiliser should be a slow-release organic feed formulated specifically for healthy and robust flowers.

Green roof plants only have a shallow layer of growing medium, so it is imperative that there is a robust, healthy plant layer. They do

not have the same access to water and nutrients as those at ground level, so the plants need to be well-nourished to withstand summertime droughts and winter frosts.

Ideally, apply in early spring and again in early summer. Periodically remove any weeds and inspect the roof twice a year. Monitor plant health, coverage, and root development, especially in the first growing season. Quickly address any drainage problems, leaks, or plant die-offs.

Building a small-scale green roof can appear daunting. But a green roof is an achievable project. By following these steps an ordinary space can be transformed into a thriving, sustainable ecosystem.

BOAT HOUSE RENOVATION BENEFITS FROM 'INTUITIVE' A. PROCTOR GROUP MEMBRANES



A former fishing bothy on the Carnoustie coast is being transformed into a beach house by retired chemical engineer David Gibson. The project uses two different membrane products from the A. Proctor Group: Facadeshield® UV and Proctor Air®.

The narrow site (3.5 m x 8 m) meant that David retained the original sleeper foundations, reducing the existing brick walls to one metre and constructing a timber frame above. Initially planning open-jointed cladding, he selected Facadeshield UV for its UV resistance, vapour permeability and water resistance. Although fire safety regulations later required switching to closed cladding, the membrane remained valuable. Left exposed for three months, it effectively protected the OSB sheathing during construction delays.

For the roof, David chose Proctor Air, an air-permeable low-resistance (APLR) membrane, ideal beneath a traditional slate finish. Its ability to ventilate the roof space and remove any risk of condensation made it particularly suitable for the building's exposed coastal location and monopitch roof design.

David praised the installation process as 'intuitive,' although he did enlist help with the roof membrane installation. With a background in engineering, he calculated U-values and condensation risk himself, supported by the A. Proctor Technical Team and Building Control.

As external works near completion, David plans to use Reflectatherm® Plus internally to improve thermal performance.


