

# **NFRC MEMBERS SPEAK UP FOR SMES**



The voice of the roofing sector was once again heard in Parliament as NFRC Members gave evidence to the Business and Trade Committee's inquiry on the forthcoming Small Business Strategy.

On 16 September, Joshua Clarke of Clarke Roofing Southern Ltd highlighted the severe challenges around skills and recruitment, bringing national attention to the lack of local training provision. MPs were surprised to learn apprentices in Eastbourne must travel all the way to Leytonstone, London, for training, an issue mirrored around the UK. Clarke also raised concerns over inconsistent funding, following the abrupt closure of CITB's Skills & Training Fund at the end of September, which has disrupted many NFRC businesses' training plans.

This was the **second time an NFRC Member contributed to the inquiry**. In June, NFRC South West Chair Paul Brain, Director of Ashcroft Services Ltd, gave evidence on the damaging impact of late payment on SMEs and the urgent need for reform.

Both appearances underline NFRC Members' consistent messages: government must do more to support SMEs by addressing skills shortages, ensuring fair payment, and giving small businesses a stronger voice in national decision-making.

# RETENTIONS REFORM: HAVE YOUR SAY

The Government is consulting on long-overdue reforms to tackle late payment and cash retentions, issues that have long undermined the financial stability of roofing businesses.



To ensure Members' voices are heard, NFRC is hosting a webinar, "Late Payment and Retention Reform Is Coming—

Have Your Say", featuring senior officials from the Department for Business and Trade on 9 October. Speakers include Fergus Harradence, Deputy Director for Construction, and Nicola Walters, Business Environment Lead for Construction and Infrastructure.

This is a rare opportunity to hear proposals first-hand, ask questions directly to policymakers, and contribute views that could shape how reforms are applied across the construction sector. NFRC has consistently campaigned for the abolition of unfair retentions, and this consultation could mark a turning point.

The consultation closes on 23 October, and it is vital that Members submit their own responses. NFRC has prepared supporting resources, please contact **policy@nfrc.co.uk** to access these and ensure your perspective is represented.

# **OVERCOMING** COMPLEX TECHNICAL CHALLENGES AT **TOTTENHAM HALE**

# **EJOT** FLAT ROOFING SOLUTION HELPS HOUSING DEVELOPER **AVOID WEATHER-RELATED DELAYS**

The EJOT JBS-R and EcoTek tube-washer fixing combination, which is designed for rapid installation of flat roof systems with tapered insulation, has been instrumental in market-leading retirement property developer McCarthy & Stone meeting the strict completion deadline at one of its latest developments in Wiltshire.

The scheme at Wichelstowe in Swindon consists of two blocks which accommodate a range of one-and two-bedroom apartments designed to offer stylish independent living for the over-60s, with around 120 new properties in total.

The original proposal was for a tapered insulation system, incorporating a Bauder PVC membrane plus mineral wool insulation, to be bonded to the concrete deck. However, given the cold weather conditions at the time of the installation window, it was not possible to apply the adhesive and an alternative had to be found.

Nationwide roofing contractor Protec Roofing was tasked with finding a solution to ensure the proposed flat roof system could still be used. Its Managing Director, Ian Green, approached EJOT UK's flat roofing specialist Kevin Rackley for assistance and the JBS-R fastener and EcoTek tube-washer combination was subsequently approved for use by Bauder.

The combination brings together a high-performing, organically-coated concrete screw (JBS-R 7.5) with a high-quality telescopic tube-washer (EcoTek) to provide a fixing solution that is adjustable to fit the required depth of insulation.

It is suitable for all types of commonly-used tapered insulation, principally mineral fibre, EPS, XPS and PIR.

# DON'T MIX AND MATCH: WHY NOT ALL MEMBRANES ARE THE SAME

It's easy to assume that all roof underlays are alike—but that's far from true. I once saw a roof patched with six different membrane types. That's extreme, but it highlights a critical issue: inconsistency undermines performance.

The worst performing membrane on a roof sets the standard for the whole system. If a membrane isn't certified for a particular use—such as with traditional Scottish sarking—it can lead to serious problems. Yet these situations often slip through during installation, even if no one would ever specify such a combination.

The make-up of a membrane directly influences its performance. Materials, additives, and manufacturing methods all play a role. For example, membranes can be made using spunbond, meltblown, or films—each offering different strengths and weaknesses.

At the PROCTOR GROUP, our Proctor Air® underlay combines spunbond layers with a meltblown core, creating a vapour- and air-permeable product that reduces condensation and supports consistent ventilation across the whole roof area.

Beyond composition, weather exposure is another critical factor. Membranes are not waterproof and should be temporarily protected if left exposed—especially during re-roofing projects. Industry guidance agrees: limit exposure time as much as possible.
